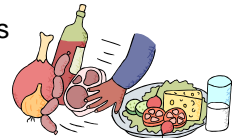


ANNUAL WELBY WAY MUSIC TALENT SHOW

LUNCH FOR 85 CENTS? CAN YOU BEAT THAT?

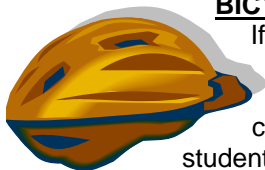

BICYCLE HELMETS



If a student rides a bicycle to school without wearing a bicycle helmet, the office will notify the student's parent or guardian that the student will not be allowed to ride the bicycle home without a bicycle helmet, in compliance with the California Bicycle Helmet Law. This law states that children seventeen and younger must wear a bicycle helmet at all times while riding a bicycle. If a student rides a bicycle to school without a helmet, the parent or guardian will be contacted by the office and offered three choices: 1) the student can go home without the bicycle, 2) the parent may come and pick up the student and the bicycle, or 3) the school retains the bicycle until the student is able to wear a bicycle helmet and ride home on the bicycle.
