AB 1802 - Major One-Time Funding: \$30,000 total to spend. Mr. Merritt discussed the school's needs at the faculty meeting today. \$3,000 will be spent on library books and the rest on technology. Our technology needs are broad and Mr. Merritt has put together committees to look at our school's needs in this area. The problem is that our school has to use the district's supplier and they are more expensive than other vendors. Ms. Yoo pointed out that the advantage of going with the district's supplier is that we receive tech support. We need to spend this money by the middle of May.

Arts Funding: \$6,000. Music teachers are taking about half of the money to purchase percussion instruments and other music supplies. The rest will be spent on other arts supplies such as plays and visual arts materials.

Traffic: Traffic around the school has been bad lately. We have sent home flyers but still no improvement. Mr. Merritt has called to inquire about video enforcement. There is a lot of double parking and illegal turns. Mr. Merritt has had a lot of complaints and feels it is getting dangerous out there.
